Weather Situation

A trough of low pressure over western New South Wales is expected to move east and clear the coast overnight tonight. Unsettled conditions ahead of the trough are expected to continue today. A low is expected to develop east of Tasmania on Sunday with a south to southwesterly airstream being directed over the state.

Forecast for the rest of Saturday 23 October

Partly cloudy. Areas of fog early this morning. Medium (60%) chance of showers during this afternoon and evening. The chance of a thunderstorm during this afternoon and evening. Light winds becoming west to northwesterly 15 to 25 km/h in the morning then tending west to southwesterly in the evening. Daytime maximum temperatures in the mid to high 20s.

Partly cloudy. High (70%) chance of showers in the southeast, slight (30%) chance elsewhere. Winds northwest to southwesterly 20 to 30 km/h tending northeast to southeasterly 15 to 20 km/h in the late evening. Overnight temperatures falling to between 6 and 9 with daytime temperatures reaching between 17 and 20.
